## **Thanksgiving Mini-Buntings**

These buntings are single-sided, so they're best used where the backs won't be seen, like against a wall (if you're hanging them) or on a table (like in a flatlay).



## **Instructions:**

- 1. Cut out flags.
- 2. Fold top of each flag about 1/2 inch toward back (unprinted side) of paper to form a tab.
- 3. Cut 24-inch [61 cm] (or longer) piece of string or yarn.
- 4. Place yarn or string inside the folds of the flags, and tape the tabs down.
- 5. Adjust the spacing of the letters as desired.
