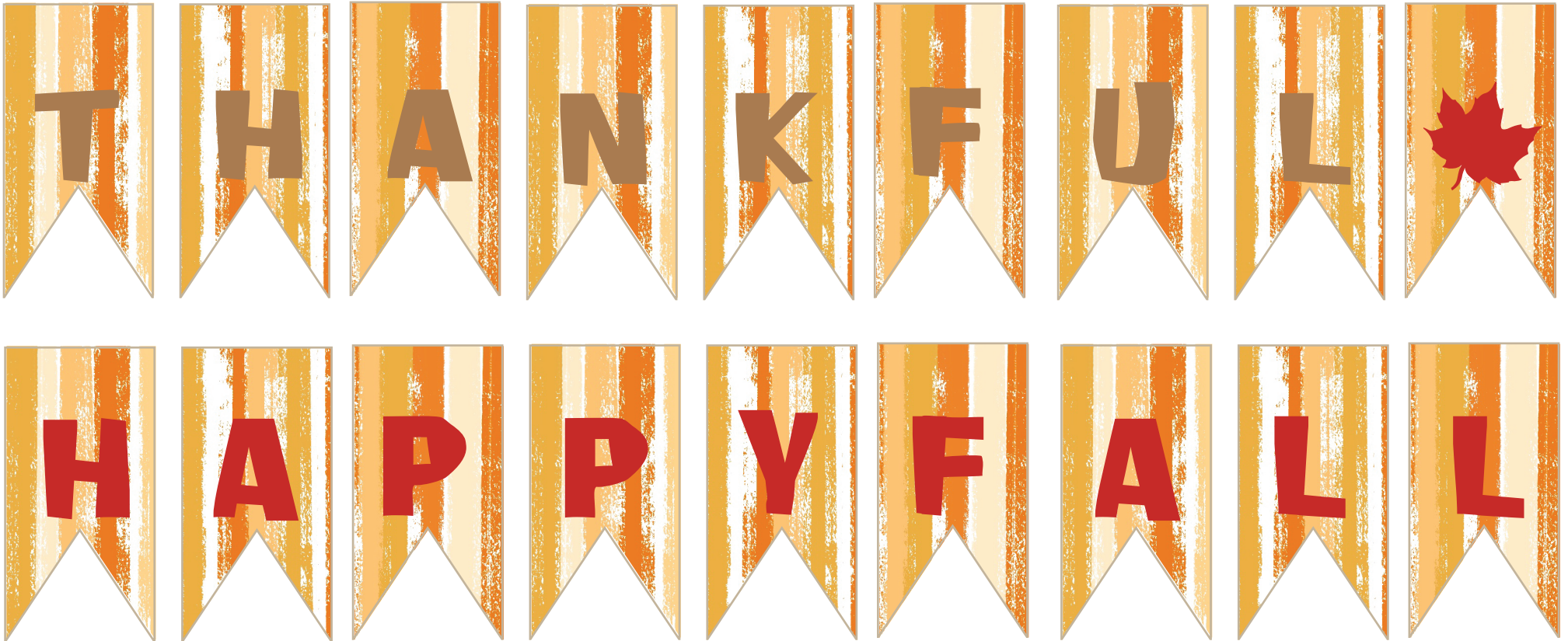


# Thanksgiving Mini-Buntings

These buntings are single-sided, so they're best used where the backs won't be seen, like against a wall (if you're hanging them) or on a table (like in a flatlay).



## Instructions:

1. Cut out flags.
2. Fold top of each flag about 1/2 inch toward back (unprinted side) of paper to form a tab.
3. Cut 24-inch [61 cm] (or longer) piece of string or yarn.
4. Place yarn or string inside the folds of the flags, and tape the tabs down.
5. Adjust the spacing of the letters as desired.

Note that the maple leaf is meant to be used as a divider between “happy” and “fall.”
